



**Dr Marek Kozlowski** is currently a Senior Lecturer at the Faculty of Design and Architecture, University Putra Malaysia. He graduated from the University of Queensland as an Urban Planner and completed his Master in Architecture at the Technical University in Krakow, Poland. He received his PhD in Urban Design at the University of Queensland. He has worked as an Urban Planner in Brisbane City Council and as an architect/urban designer for private consultancies in Queensland, Australia Poland, United Arab Emirates, Oman and Saudi Arabia. In 2006, he joined Gold Coast City Council in Queensland Australia as a Senior Urban Designer and managed and coordinated major projects including; the Central Southport Master Plan and the Gold Coast Rapid Transit Corridor Study. He has worked as a lecturer and tutor at the University of Queensland and conducted visiting lectures at universities in Australia, Brunei, Malaysia and Poland. He has done consultancy work in Malaysia for DPZ Asia where he was involved in various projects including the Urban Design Guidelines for Central Kuala Lumpur.

A part of the DPZ Asia team he was also involved in other major projects including: the Conceptual Master Plan for Teluk Datai Eco Village Resort in Langkawi, Conceptual Layout Plan for the Padang Precinct, Isthmus in Kuching, Sarawak, Conceptual Plan for a Residential Estate in Haiphong, Vietnam and the Development Plan for Cameroon Highlands.

Marek has joined UPM in 2013. He has been involved in coordinating and preparation of the Master in Tropical Urban Design course. His research interests are in the fields of urban design, planning and urban regeneration. He has just completed a three year research on the Tropical Design Guidelines for Public Spaces in the Kuala Lumpur Metropolitan Region as part of a major research project; 'Developing Indicators for Sustainable Tropical Pedestrian Environment for the Kuala Lumpur Metropolitan Region'.
