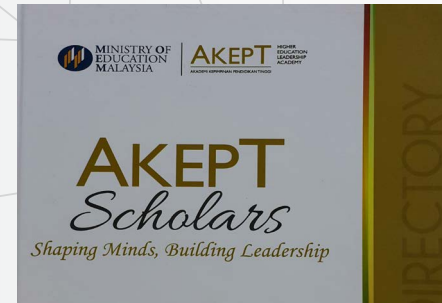
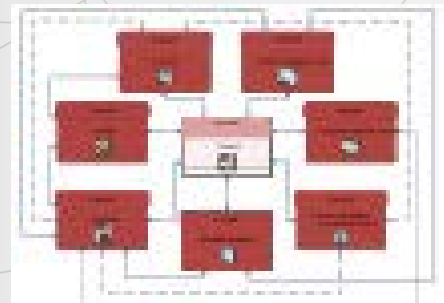
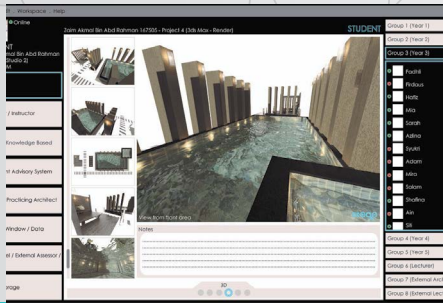

She edited and wrote articles, conference papers, journals and book chapters in STEdex, PAX publications and the 'Thinking Hands of Hajeedar' book. She peer-reviewed articles in conferences and academic journals such as the Journal of Built Environment (UKM), and Pertanika Journal of Social Sciences and Humanities.

Besides teaching and involving in the curriculum development for the faculty, Roslina is very passionate in the student and academics development at the university level. She is a trainer with the Co-Curriculum and Student Development Centre and the Centre of Academic Development at UPM. At the national level, she is listed in the Higher Education Leadership Academy (AKEPT-MOE) Scholar's Directory for her contribution in its Academic Development Programme and her role as a master trainer and module writer for the Project-Oriented Problem Based Learning approach since 2011.
