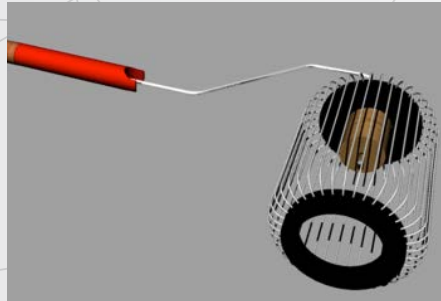
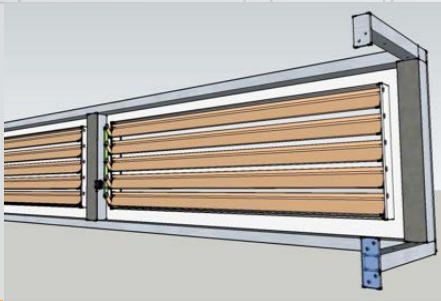

Previously, he was a practising industrial designer, working at several designs and manufacturing companies. He had more than 15 years experience in product designing, as well as managing many local and international projects before joining UPM. Throughout the years, he also managed to execute several consultancy projects.
