## INTERNAL CIRCULATION:

IMPLEMENTATION OF ONLINE TEACHING AND LEARNING ACTIVITIES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS OF BACHELOR OF SC. IN ARCHITECTURE WITH HONOURS (PART I) AND MASTER OF ARCHITECTURE (PART II) AT THE FACULTY OF DESIGN AND ARCHITECTURE, UNIVERSITI PUTRA MALAYSIA FOR SEMESTER 1, 2020/2021

Assalamualaikum and Good Day,

- 1. In accordance with the announcement by the Ministry of Higher Education Malaysia dated 16 July 2020, Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) will resume face-to-face teaching and learning (T&L) activities for undergraduate and postgraduate programs for the first semester 2020/2021 academic session which will begin on 19 October 2020, as per UPM Internal Circulation dated 4 September 2020.
- 1. However, due to the travel restrictions imposed by the Government of Malaysia to certain number of countries and limited flights to Malaysia, the Faculty of Design and Architecture has received many requests from the international students to continue their studies virtually. After careful consideration, the faculty has decided that the first and final year International students of Bachelor of Science in Architecture with Honours (Part I) and Master of Architecture (Part II) who are unable to attend face-to-face classes are required to defer their studies as these programs are subject to face to face teaching and learning as required by the Board of Architects Malaysia (LAM) in Nota Khas MAPS #4-2020.
- 2. Other than the first and final year International students for the above mentioned programs, the faculty has decided to allow the international students to resume their studies and attend the online classes as allowed by the Board of Architects Malaysia (LAM) in Nota Khas MAPS #4-2020.
- 3. This circulation is only applicable for international students of these two programs at the Faculty of Design and Architecture. Local students are required to return to the campus for the coming semester in October as per previous circulation.
- 4. International students from other countries (not in the restricted list) can still return to Malaysia, but must strictly follow the guidelines as per previous circulation. - 5. Any changes to the current instruction will be updated from time to time, based on the latest situation in Malaysia.
